

Q. Is there a way to get college credit for GWR's courses?

Yes, there is a way. GWR has coordinated with University of Montana's School of Extended & Lifelong Learning (SELL) so students can get one (1) college credit. Anyone can enroll for one University of Montana college credit after they register and pay for the GWR's wildlife handling and chemical immobilization course. Here is what you would do to:

1. Register and pay for a GWR course by either visiting our Training Schedule webpage, selecting the course you wish to attend and registering through PayPal or by sending us a check payable to Global Wildlife Resources.
2. When you register, please let Dr. Mark know that you would like to either get one (1) college credit for the course. Dr. Mark will provide you with a credit registration form.
3. Submit UM Credit Registration form and payment for \$155 credit fee to Holly Kulish (Holly.Kulish@mso.umt.edu) at University of Montana. UM will enroll you for credit & send a confirmation email.
4. Attend the course

If you cannot attend the course, you must notify both Global Wildlife Resources and the University of Montana's School of Extended & Lifelong Learning (SELL).
