Q. How do I get a college student discount?

To get the student discount, email Dr. Mark at info@wildliferesources.com identifying your college with proof of being a student such as with a college email address. Dr. Mark will send you a coupon to reduce the Foundations course fee to \$525 (save \$55). The coupon link will take you to the Checkout Page with your discount to purchase the Foundations course or you can [go here to register without the discount](#)

Q. How can I get college credit for GWR's online Foundations course?

Here are two options.

- 1) Contact your advisor and ask if you can take this course for Independent Study.
- 2) Global Wildlife Resources (GWR) has coordinated with University of Montana's Extended Credit officer so students can receive one (1) undergraduate semester credit. The course will be listed as WILD 391 Foundations of Wildlife Chemical Capture on a University of Montana transcript. It uses Credit/No Credit (pass/fail) grading.

It is the student's responsibility to verify the transferability of courses to their degree-granting institution and intended major.

Anyone can enroll for one University of Montana college credit after they register and pay for the GWR's online course, "[The Foundations of Wildlife Chemical Capture](#)". Here is how to enroll:

1. Get a College Student Discount! Simply ask Dr. Mark as described above. You don't have to have a student discount to enroll. You can also enroll if you pay the general fee for the course.
2. Use the coupon to register and pay for the Foundations course. The student coupon link will take you to the Checkout Page or you can [go here to register without the discount](#).
3. Attend the course.
4. After you have completed the course, submit the [UM Credit Registration Form](#) and a payment of \$155 for the college credit fee to Holly Kulish (Holly.Kulish@mso.umt.edu) at University of Montana. UM will enroll you for credit & send a confirmation email.
5. Upon finishing the course, notify Holly and Dr. Mark. Dr. Mark will submit your final grade to UM.
